THE BASICS

Caribbean Stud is a five card poker game that matches your hand against the dealer's hand.

HOW TO PLAY

Each player places an "ante bet" in the betting circle. Players are then dealt five cards face down. The dealer receives four cards face down and one card face up. After all cards are dealt, you may look at your cards and decide to play or fold. If you chose to play, you then place a bet that is twice your ante bet to "call" the dealer. If you choose to fold, you then lose your ante bet.

After all the players have made their decisions, the dealer then reveals the remaining four cards. If the dealer does not have a poker ranking hand of Ace/King or higher, the hand is over and the ante bets are paid at even money to the players. If the dealer has an Ace/King or higher, your ante will be paid at even money and your call wager will qualify for a bonus based on the schedule below:

PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT

You play the progressive jackpot by placing a \$1 on the betting sensor after making your ante bet and prior to receiving your cards. Regardless of the dealer's hand, it is paid as listed below.

Player Hand	Payoff	Dealer Hand Payoff
Any Pair	1 to 1	—
Two Pair	2 to 1	—
Three-of-a-Kind	3 to 1	—
Straight	4 to 1	\$25
Flush	5 to 1	\$50
Full House	7 to 1	\$100
Four-of-a-Kind	20 to 1	\$500
Straight Flush	50 to 1	10% of Jackpot
Royal Flush	100 to 1	100% of Jackpot

These payouts are in addition to the progressive jackpot payout. Payouts not to exceed table maximums.

Gratuities may be offered in return for providing great guest service. You can offer a gratuity by giving a chip to your dealer or server. You may also wager your chip on behalf of the dealer by placing it with any bet that you make for yourself.
